1. Jesus is conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit in the womb of the Virgin Mary. (Mt.1:18-25)
2. Jesus is consecrated as the Messiah by the Holy Spirit in the Jordan. (Lk. 3:21- 22; Jn.1:29-34; Acts 10:37-38)
3. Jesus dies on the Cross to take away the sins of the world, and gives the Holy Spirit. (Jn.19: 28-30)
4. The Risen Jesus gives the Apostles the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins. (Jn 20:19-23)
5. At Pentecost, the Father and Jesus pour out the Holy Spirit; the Church, thus empowered, opens itself to its mission in the world. (Act. 2:1-6 ; Act. 2:29-36)
6. For the first time, the Holy Spirit descends upon the Gentiles. (Acts 10:44-48)
7. The Holy Spirit guides the Church at all times, giving it His gifts and charisms (1 Cor. 12:4-11 ; 1 Cor 12; Jn. 16:12-15; Jn 17:20-23)

You may follow the Rosary with the Litany and the Act of self-giving and consecration to the Holy Spirit.

Bring to the Lord our prayer intentions, vocal or in the silence of our heart.

Note by Cardinal Mercier regarding his prayer to the Holy Spirit.

I am going to reveal to you the secret of sanctity and happiness. Every day for five minutes control your imagination and close your eyes to all the noise of the world in order to enter into yourself. Then, in the sanctuary of your baptised soul (which is the temple of the Holy Spirit) speak to that Divine Spirit, saying to Him (his prayer above). If you do this, your life will flow along happily, serenely, and full of consolation, even in the midst of trials. Grace will be proportioned to the trial, giving you the strength to carry it and you will arrive at the Gate of Paradise, laden with merit. This submission to the Holy Spirit is the secret of sanctity.

NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

1 Holy Spirit, **gift of God to my soul**, I am astonished by the interior feelings and admiration I have thinking of you. Nothing expresses the inner happiness I feel knowing you, the most sweet guest of my soul and Divine life within me. The soul is flooded with silent, loving and delightful contemplation of you.

You amaze me: your beauty is stupendous beyond anything the mind can imagine, your riches of grace: gifts, virtues and beatitudes are inexhaustible.

Your tender goodness induces you to dwell in me. You have everything, your riches can do everything and you want to give me everything. How I admire you, despite my misery which renders me the least of all on earth. I bless you, I adore you, I thank you and I ask you for everything. Give me everything O Holy Spirit.

Glory be...

2 Spirit of the Lord and **Heavenly Giver of Gifts**, with my deepest humility, but also with all the strength of my ardent desires, I ask you to give me your holy gifts, especially wisdom and piety.

Let these gifts grow in me to their complete development, so that my soul may be docile and obedient to you, interior Master, and so that I may always live by your gifts and in the sweet and intimate contemplation of you and of the whole Holy Trinity.

3 Holy Spirit, **interior Master and sanctifier**, I ask you, with untiring persistence, to teach my intellect all truth, to speak to my heart, You would like to sanctify me, caring for my soul, as you cared for that of our Lady, your Immaculate Spouse, of the Martyr and the Saints.

4 Holy Spirit, **truth and blessed light**, I feel deep bitterness that you are almost completely unknown or forgotten by a great many of us.

We don't think about You at all, distracted as we are by many worries, absorbed by the spirit of the world, careless and not concerned about your kindness and thoughtfulness. What ungratefulness! Most of this fault is our own as we don't live this truth and do not speak about it to souls.

Holy Spirit, accept my poor sentiments in atonement for so much deplorable omission, and as a request for great light for me, for the Priests, and for the faithful.

Glory be...

5 Holy Spirit, **love and suavity of the Father and the Son, flower and perfume of God's holiness** - divine fire lit in me - make my heart completely new. Remove every stain and darkness, burn up every impurity, and conform me to the image of the divine Son.

Spirit of fire, who deign to dwell in me personally to sanctify me, ignite in me this fire of love. Penetrate and invest my entire soul with your flame and dispel every disordered attachment. Move me to apostolic conquest and grant me the grace to be a flame, a blaze of pure and eternal love.

Glory be...

6 **Spirit of fortitude**, who gave the martyrs the strength to die gladly for the cause of Christ the Lord, infuse in me this divine gift with all its intensity.

Stir me from my torpor and my indolence. Make me strong in undertaking all that the Lord asks me without regard for the sacrifices and toils involved. May this be for your glory and for the spiritual and material benefit of everyone.

Give me the strength to continue with ardour, without tiring and without abandoning what I have begun.

Give me courage and zeal in defending the Church, proclaiming the integrity of Faith and true obedience to the Pope and Bishops before everyone.

Increase supernatural strength in my apostolate; may I persevere to the end, even to martyrdom of the body and soul. Divine Spirit, envelop me with your omnipotence, sustain me by your vigour, and wrap me with your invincible strength.

7. Spirit of truth and light, O flame of most blessed warm light, dispel the shadows of error and doubt from my mind.

Shine perfect clarity into the deepest part of my soul. May I walk in your splendour by always rejecting error and adhering to the truth in accordance with the teaching of the Church.

Invested with your holy light, may I always remain in your truth and in pure clarity.

8 Purifying Spirit, purify me from every stain. Sanctify me and grant me the virtue of Jesus, the same intentions and inner disposition of him.

THE HOLY SPIRIT SHOULD BE BETTER KNOWN, LOVED AND GLORIFIED

Why Pray to the Holy Spirit? Here are some passages of the great message communicated by Jesus to a beloved soul of His for the salvation and sanctification of the World. They are taken from the book "Divine Power of Love".

10-11-1965 Why doesn't the Church, my Spouse, honour the Holy Spirit with a more solemn, fervent and practical cult among the faithful?

11-11-1965 Make yourself interpreter of my designs: I wish that the Church, mother and teacher of all believers, emphasizes the action of the Holy Spirit, Spirit of life, of truth, of justice, of love

2-4-1966 Listen to the voice of your beloved Lord: the cult I request to fully glorify the Holy Spirit shall not be separated from the one due to my Sacred Heart... therefore it shall not be at all a new cult... However what I ask is that my Church gives prominence to the sanctifying action of the Holy Spirit in souls... let them speak more about Him... let them make Him known... let souls understand that without this Divine Spirit it is impossible to do anything that can please the Sanctity of God three times Holy. Let them inculcate in souls a burning and confident love... let Him be invoked... let them make Him the intimate friend of every moment, because only He is the inspirer of all good. Only He transforms souls... Sanctifies hearts. He can lead humanity to salvation in this sad time

3-6-1966 From Loreto a new light will spring forth to radiate the whole earth... and bring anew warmth into the hearts of men...in the glorification of the Holy Spirit

5-8-1966 The world of today needs this new Pentecost... so that souls will feel shaken, enlightened and strengthened for a Christian life's revival... of a life that will lead them faster to salvation and holiness. Oh how much the salvation of souls is on my heart! It is a exigency which I cannot renounce

7-12-1966 The attribute that will mostly make inroads in presenting this new appeal of my Heart, in honor of the Holy Spirit, will be that which is most glorious to Him: that is, "Divine Power of Love." Do you understand? Divine Power, but Power of Love

10-12-1966 It is only right that where my Most Holy Mother is devoutly honoured in the mystery of the first moment of my Incarnation as Word of the Father, the Eternal Divine Spirit also be honoured, He who was its ineffable Maker...

24-12-1971 The Holy Spirit, Spirit of the eternal Love of the Father and the Son, will descend and take permanent dwelling in that Sacred Temple to give light and grace to all those who visit it, and it will become a centre of irradiation of the cult due to Him

1-6-1972 This is therefore the whole purpose of the Work: the glorification of the Holy Spirit. Indeed, precisely for this purpose it began, grew, and is successfully developing

28-10-1974 Get the land and start the construction of the Temple

30-11-1974 The Resources will never be lacking, because, being the Work of God, it will always be assisted and strengthened by the Power on High

20-5-1988 It is really my desire that this Temple be built, so that it can become a point of attraction for people's hearts and a Monument of praise and of glory to God from the second Millennium to the third!

21-5-1988 At the touch of my grace everything will arrive at its fulfilment... and this Work too will be erected... and the Temple too... yes, the Temple will be built too... and I will dwell in it in a very special way, so that it can become throughout future ages a centre of attraction and of Irradiation for the salvation of very many souls and of the Society!

23-5-1988 This my Temple [...] will be throughout the centuries of history, the memorial monument of the end of the Second Millennium to the Third. It will be established as a sign of light, of consolation and attraction for the salvation of souls in honour of the Holy Church of the true God, and to the glory and honour of the eternal Divine Spirit for ever and ever

THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

aims to put in place all the means to:

- make the faithful **know, love and glorify** the Holy Spirit;
- promote a **more solemn, ardent and practical worship** of the Holy Spirit in the Church
- **give prominence to the action of the Holy Spirit in giving life and love, truth and justice** to souls and society.

The Work includes the lay Association “Divine Power of Love” which is canonically established by the Bishop of Palestrina (Rome) and composed of the faithful: men and women in their secular state of life who testify as Disciples and Apostles of the Holy Spirit, and of Religious Families, of men and women, also established canonically who live in their respective religious Houses of Palestrina.

They are souls who promptly welcome the call of the Lord and devote themselves to the Divine Power of Love. They obey the voice of Jesus: “I will inspire souls with so much good will that they will guide the Work along the paths of my designs.” (11-12-1974).

Beautiful prayers and elevations remind us that every Christian soul is already a DISCIPLE and APOSTLE of the Holy Spirit, by the power of Baptism.

As a disciple, the soul must remember that:

- at Baptism, the Christian soul received the Holy Spirit.
- The presence of the Holy Spirit, makes the soul a Temple of God.
- the Holy Spirit is God and can be saddened and even driven out by sin.
- the Holy Spirit dwells in the soul as the Mover that puts everything in motion, as the Guide who directs everything, as the Master who teaches everything, as the Friend who keeps the soul constant company.
- it is necessary for the soul to only be moved and guided by His gentle inspiration. The soul should accept His divine teachings and keep Him as its sole companion.
- His divine presence makes the soul a daughter of the Father, a sister of Jesus, and a spouse of the Holy Spirit.
- the constant presence of the Holy Spirit introduces the soul into the circle of divine life, through which God lives in the soul and the soul in God.
- the sweet Guest cannot be left alone: the soul must live by Him, for Him, in Him. So continuous absorption of mind, assiduous prayer and sweet conversation are necessary at all times, in all places, and in every kind of work.
- Through the Holy Spirit, the soul shares in the nobility of the divine family: it should never refuse through sin, this elevated dignity.

As an apostle, the believer should remember that:

- on the day of their Holy Confirmation, the soul has accepted the solemn duty, impressed with an indelible character, to be a living image of Christ and to be a witness to Him everywhere and always.
- this commitment stimulates and urges the soul to unceasingly spread Christ's Kingdom everywhere.
- the zeal of the soul should be similar to that of the Apostles after the descent of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost.
- the speech of the soul shall enkindle Faith, Hope and Charity, and fight against evil of every kind, everywhere and at all times should destroy the kingdom of darkness to build up the Kingdom of Christ.
- the soul has the duty, through its words and actions, to make people understand that they are God's temples and should have the greatest respect for their body and soul.
- Christians should be aware that the Holy Spirit, who is in them through the grace of Baptism, has elevated them to the greatest dignity, through which have become children of God.
- they should defend their divine nobility from all assaults of the Evil One, by loving the truth and the good, and by avoiding evil.
- as our Redemption, accomplished by Christ, was a work of this Divine Power of Love, so, also the application of the fruits of Redemption through the Sacraments is a work of the same Divine Spirit.
- everything will be renewed if the baptised person receives His light, His love, His strength.
- the supernatural life of the Church and in our souls is completely the work of the Holy Spirit.
- the Centre undertakes a wide apostolate in Italy and abroad. It is in continual development and has started the construction of the Temple and the Citadel for the glorification of the Holy Spirit, according to the divine desire to create a center to worship and adore the Divine Power of Love.
- the Centre serves those interested in or engaged with groups of the Holy Spirit to provide information, advice and spiritual insight about the Holy Spirit Apostolate.

Groups of Disciples and Apostles of the Holy Spirit

We exhort all members to form Cenacles of prayer to make the Holy Spirit better known, loved and glorified.

These groups can be formed within a family or among several families, or even by a few individuals coming together to honour the Holy Spirit. They can meet in any place at any time. It is optimal if they meet weekly, if not, every fortnightly and at least monthly.

At the meeting, in imitation of Our Lady and the Apostles in the Cenacle, they listen to the Word of God, read and comment on it, and say prayers and invocations to the Holy Spirit. They should have with them a copy of the New Testament, the book "Divine Power of Love" and this booklet. **Where possible, cenacles should come together in the church and in accordance with the Pastor, a monthly votive Mass of the Holy Spirit should be celebrated.**

We extend our invitation to particularly sensitive souls, to those who need light, strength and love. These are the little and innocent ones. May all leave the cenacles better spiritually prepared, hopeful, and more enlightened. The Holy Spirit is never invoked in vain!

Thousands of these small cenacles will bring a new wave of fire of the Holy Spirit and renew the face of the earth.

In order to make the Holy Spirit known, loved and glorified and to facilitate the formation of the cenacles, we have printed some texts, among them the book “Divine Power of Love”; all our materials including meditations (in Italian) and are in mp3 format can be found on our website.

Duties of the disciples and apostles

- The Disciples and Apostles of the Holy Spirit know and embrace all the Truths professed by the Holy Catholic Church and refute everything which is contrary to her teachings.
- Those enrolled, accepting the ends of the Association described in its Statutes, consecrate themselves to the Divine Power of Love, to which they give their intellect, their heart, their will and their whole being, temple of the Holy Spirit.
- They commit themselves to make the Holy Spirit known, loved and glorified in order to promote a more solemn, ardent and practical worship of Him and to give prominence to his action of life, truth, justice and love.
- Remembering the words of Jesus: “Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them “ (Matthew 18:20), they organise Cenacles of Prayer in one or more families, and in the parishes some become team leaders.
- They offer Him a time of prayer and all the joys and sufferings of the day. **They dedicate the first Wednesday of the month to the Holy Spirit and organise and promote a monthly Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit in parishes and in other public oratories.** They do an annual Novena in preparation for the feast of Pentecost. They invoke the Holy Spirit several times daily with the Sequence and with short prayers, they pray the Angelus, remembering the Incarnation of the Word of God, of which the Holy Spirit was the ineffable Author.

THE IMPORTANCE OF THE VOTIVE MASS TO THE HOLY SPIRIT.

The rich liturgical patrimony of the Church offers a Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit.

In “principals and norms” for the use of the Roman Missal (the Missal is a book that the Priest uses daily for the celebration of the Holy Mass) we read the following (cf 326-329): “The liturgy of the sacraments and sacramentals offer the well-disposed faithful the means to sanctify the events of life through the grace that flows from the Pascal Mystery. The Eucharist is the sacrament of the sacraments and the Missal presents Mass and prayer forms which are used for different circumstances in Christian life and for the needs of the whole world and of the universal or local Church. Masses for various circumstances are of three kinds: Ritual, Votive and masses for various needs. Ritual Masses are connected to the celebrations of some sacraments or sacramentals such as Baptism, Sacred Order, Marriage, etc. Votive Masses are offered to commemorate Mysteries of the Lord, to honour the Blessed Virgin Mary or the saints. Masses for various needs -as the word itself suggests - are for particular needs like peace in the event of war, relief from natural or other man made disasters such as earthquakes, floods, famine and so on. Another kind are masses for the Holy Souls The forms of all these masses are rich and varied.

WHY A VOTIVE MASS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Vatican II rediscovered and re-evaluated the presence and action of the Third Person of the Holy Spirit in creation and especially in the work of Salvation and Sanctification of man. The documents of the Council and the subsequent Magisterium specifically in the Encyclical on the Holy Spirit entitled “Dominum et Vivificatem” by St John Paul II, 1986. Also the Missals of the Roman and Ambrosian rites give multiple forms for the votive mass of the Holy Spirit. These rites govern the celebration of the Mass and they offer varied and rich forms (two in the Roman rite and three in the Ambrosian for Pentecost) for a votive Mass to the Holy Spirit which are not offered in votive masses to other mysteries of the faith.

(Note: in the Roman Rite, see 931A,932B, 934C and in the Ambrosian Rite, see pg 1126 et seq)
The writings of Blesseds and Saints whose inspired writings should be accepted with respect and sincere devotion because the Church gives us these individuals as models for all the faithful. Among them we especially remember Blessed Elena Guerra (1835-1914) of the Oblate of the Holy Spirit, defined by Pope John Paul XXIII, Apostle of the Holy Spirit of modern times and Saint Mary of Jesus Crucified (1846 – 1878), Discalced Carmelite. She is also known as Maryam of Bethlehem, “the little Arab”, distinguished for the spiritual gifts like the stigmata, but above all for her humility, obedience and devotion to the Holy Spirit and a great love for the Church and for the Pope. The Holy Spirit told her one day: “ **I've a burning desire and I'd like you to communicate it: I ardently desire that Priests say a Mass each month in honor of the Holy Spirit. Whoever says that Mass or hears it will be honored by the Holy Spirit Himself. He will have light; he will have peace. He will cure the sick. He will awaken those who sleep. They won't die in darkness..**”

Many movements and works recognised by the Holy See or in their own Dioceses have arisen under this new impulse, with a Pneumatological spirituality or charism. Among these is the “Opera dello Spirito Santo” in Palestrina which was born of a burning desire and new appeal from the Heart of Jesus to Mother Carolina Venturella F.d.C.C. Jesus wants the Holy Spirit to be better known, honoured, loved and glorified, in the Church and all over the world through a more solemn, ardent and practical worship in which he will be given the glorious title, “Divine Power of Love.” Jesus,

speaking to a “Poor Soul” (Mother Carolina) conferred on the Founder, P.David de Angelis O.F.M the mission to find the means of the glorification of the Holy Spirit and provided him with necessary Divine assistance. The works which began in the 1970’s include preaching, publishing and establishing cenacles of prayer. **Fr David asked those who share the charism to celebrate and participate in the monthly Mass of the Holy Spirit.**

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A VOTIVE MASS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND A MASS IN HONOUR OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit uses the special form present in the Missals (as indicated above), and the celebrant does not have to have the intention of offering the mass to honour the Holy Spirit. This Votive Mass is said on days and indeed liturgical times allowed by the Church (see Principles and rules for the use of the Roman Missal). In more prominent liturgical periods of the year (as for example, in Lent), it isn't usually possible, unless for specific reasons and with the consent of the Local Ordinary, it can still be done. When it isn't possible to celebrate the Votive Mass of the Holy Spirit, nothing prohibits participation in the Eucharistic celebration, with the particular intention of honouring the Holy Spirit. It is optimal to ask the Priest to apply the above intention to the Mass.
